- 2. What is the difference between self-denial and denial of self?
- 3. Mark 8 36-37 reads, For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? Or what shall a man give in exchange for his Soul? Now read the Genesis account of Abraham returning form the battle of the kings in Genesis 14:21-23. Any conclusions?
- 4. Read Peter's take on the Transfiguration as it is given to us in II Peter 1:16-18. What conclusions can be taken from it?
- 5. Now read II Peter 1:19. Comments?
- 6. Read Leviticus 23:34-36. Read Deuteronomy 16:13-17. Zechariah 14:16-19

Do you suppose Peter had *any* of these verses in mind when he spoke of building three tabernacles?

- 7. How do you suppose Peter, James, and John knew that it was Moses and Elijah that were talking with Jesus?
- 8. In retrospect, why do you suppose the Transfiguration comes after Jesus teaching on "taking up your cross"?
