- 3. Read Exodus 12:15. Do you suppose this has something to do with Jesus' cleansing of the temple?
- 4. Read verse 18. Isn't this behavior exclusively forbidden in Exodus 20:13? Please comment on why you think that the scribes and the chief priests believe it to be okay?
- 5. Read verses 20-24
