Mark 12:28-44

If you could know the absolute and total truth to one question, what question would you ask?

- 1. Do you suppose the scribe of verse 28 is trying to trip Jesus up like the Pharisees and the Herodians (v. 13) the Sadducees (v.18) or do you suppose that he really wants to know the answer to his question?
- 2. Theological Modalists (persons who believe that God is not trinitarian) use verse 29 as a "proof text". Does this verse disprove the trinity?
- 3. Can Modalists go to Heaven?
- 4. Read verse 34. Do you suppose this scribe is in heaven?
- 5. Read Psalm 110. Comments?
- 6. Last week, question 3 stated, "Jesus is certainly being very pointed with the religious leaders of the day. Do you suppose that He loves them or hates them. Site evidence for your choice." Read verses 38-40. Same question.
- 7. Read verses 41-44. The truth they convey is obvious. Why do they come at this point in the narrative?
