2. Read verse 18. Comment.
3. Read chapter 11:1-7. Why is God rehearsing these specific aspects of Israel's history?
4. Read verses 10-11. Why is God comparing Egyptian irrigation with Israel's hydrological cycle?
5. Read verse 14. What is God promising? Is there something symbolic in this verse? Read Hosea 6:3.
6. Read verse 17. Do you suppose that God is "withholding rain" from America?
7. Verses 22-23 comprise an "if/then" proposition. It seems that a very real choice is being offered to Israel. How does this square with Deuteronomy 4:37 and 10:15?
