3. Read Deuteronomy 30:1-10. What promises can be found in these verses? Which ones speak most deeply to you right now and why?
4. Read verses 15 -18. Comment.
5. Read Romans 10:9-11; Acts 2:37-39; Luke 9:23-24. What does choosing life, blessing, and prosperity look like today?
6. Why would people choose cursing over blessing?
7. What does it mean that “the Lord is your life” v. 20? Think of your relationship with God, what does that look like specifically for you?
