- 1. Read Deuteronomy 31:1-3. Read John 1:17. Why do you suppose that Moses could not lead the children of Israel into the Promised Land? Why do you suppose that Joshua could do what Moses couldn't do?
- 2. Read verses 6-8. Since we are not facing Sihon or Og, is there anything in this verse for us?
- 3. Read verses 9-13. Read Galatians 2:16. Is there conflict here?
- 4. Read verses 14-18. God is prophesying that Joshua's career will be mostly marked by failure. Do you suppose this prophecy corresponds to Jesus' ministry?
- 5. Read verses 19-22. God knowing that Israel would turn away, why do you suppose He went through the trouble of bringing them into the Promised Land to begin with?
- 6. Read verse 21, 26, and 28. There seems to be a tremendous emphasis on providing a "witness" against the apostasy of the tribes of Israel. Why do you suppose this is important?
- 7. Read Psalm 14:1. What do you suppose God means when He uses the word "fool"?
