- 2. Read verse 22. Righteousness does *not* come by keeping the law. What are some strategies that you have adopted to prevent yourself from allowing your relationship with God to become "works based"?
- 3. Read verse 24. What does this verse mean to you?
- 4. If God has declared us "NOT GUILTY!" (and He certainly has) in light of the fact that we are most certainly sinners, isn't God guilty of being a lenient judge?
- 5. Why do you suppose that in light of the glorious Gospel of God, many, if not most people still try to *earn* salvation by living up to a certain standard?
- 6. Read Psalm 45. Which verse speaks to you?
